

DIVE THE EXHMAS HOBART - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where is the exHMAS Hobart dive site?

It is approximately 4 nautical miles from the Marina St Vincent Cove, south of Yankalilla. Entry to the marina is via Wirrina Resort. To dive the site you will need to book with a commercial dive operator, use your own boat or contact the Scuba Divers Federation.

What do I need to do before diving?

All divers must obtain a permit to dive the site. Whether you are with a commercial operator or taking out your own boat, all divers must receive notification that they have received a permit prior to entering the site. Dive permits are available online at www.exhmashobart.com.au

Do I need to go with an accredited tour operator?

No, you can dive independently provided you have all the scuba skills and qualifications required. All details of what is required will be asked when applying for a permit.

How do I secure my boat on the water while diving?

There are six mooring buoys available to use on the site. There are also swim lines available for divers to lead on. It is recommended that all divers familiarise themselves with the buoy positions prior to launching any vessel. A diagram is available online at www.exhmashobart.com.au

You can secure your boat to any of the mooring buoys available but you must not moor your boat on the swim lines.

How many boats can tie up to a mooring buoy?

Only one boat at a time can tie up to a mooring buoy. If there are no mooring buoys available when you wish to dive you must wait until one is available to use. There is no booking system for using the buoys. It is on a first come, first served basis.

What rules apply?

When entering the dive site you must adhere to all conditions outlined in your permit and code of practice that you will receive once you obtain your permit.

What do I do if see any misconduct on the dive site?

You must report any misconduct to the relevant regulatory bodies. Contact details are available on signage at the marina or online at www.exhmashobart.com.au
